

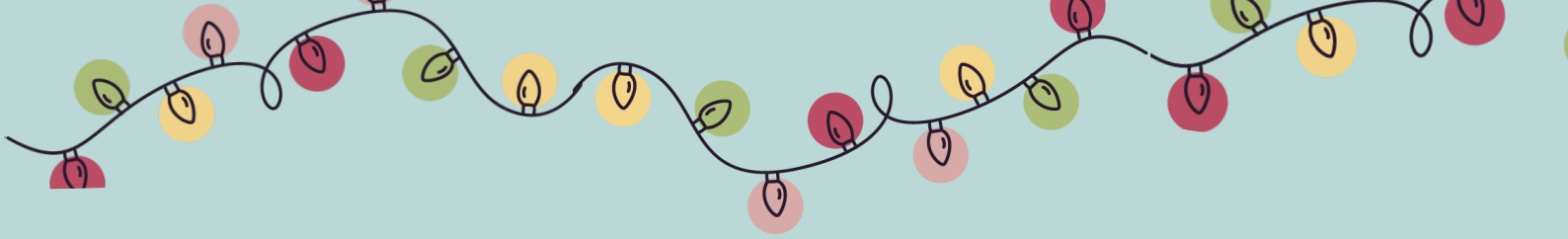

  8. In Ten Pin Bowling, how many pins are in the back row?
  9. Which well-known Hollywood actor's real name was Issur Danielovitch Demsky? In 1960, he starred as the title character in a blockbuster about a Thracian slave who rebels against Roman rule.
  10. In which year was the Queen's Christmas broadcast first televised? You can have 1 year either side of the correct answer for the point.

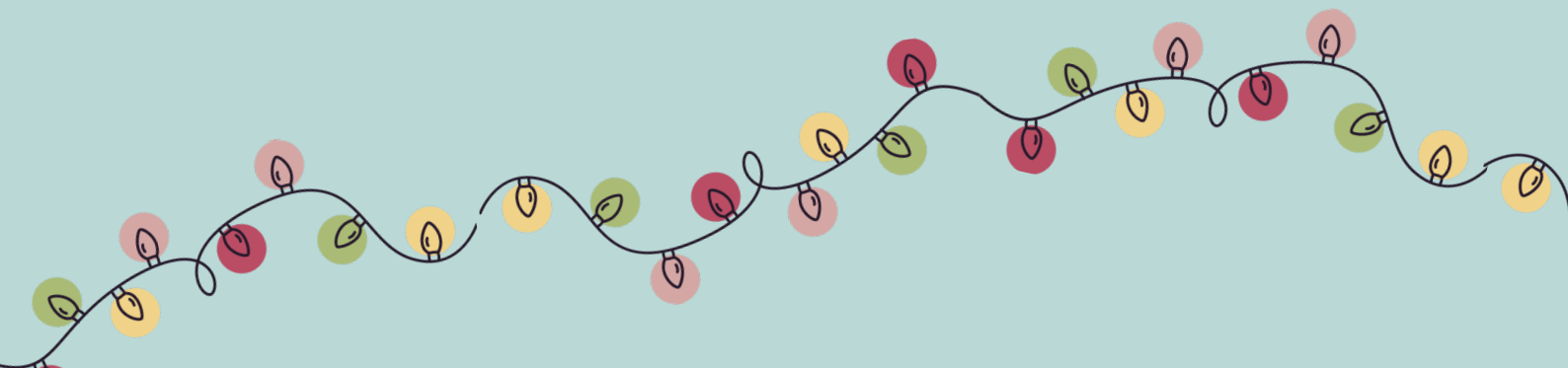
## ROUND 2 - TOP 5

SCORING: 1 point per correct answer. Total points available: 32. **Target Score: 19**



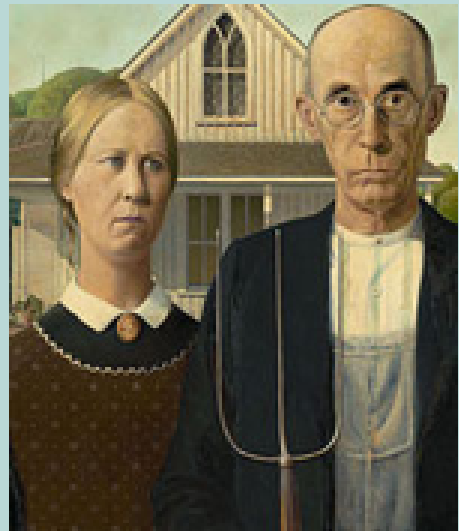

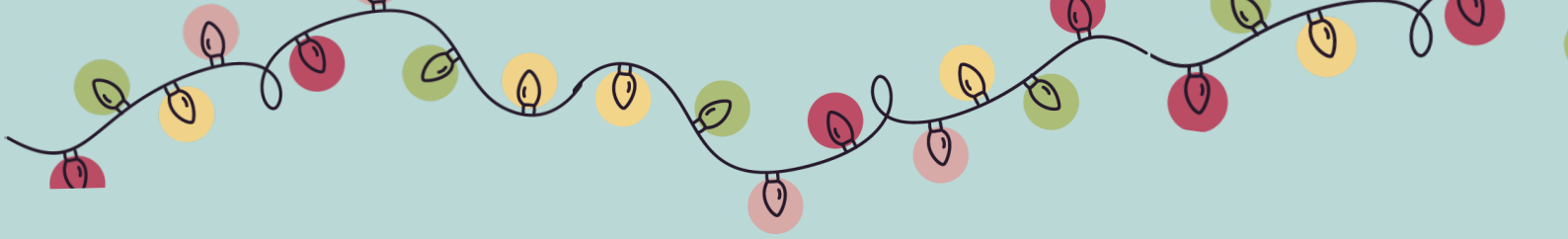


## ROUND 4 - BOOK CHARACTERS

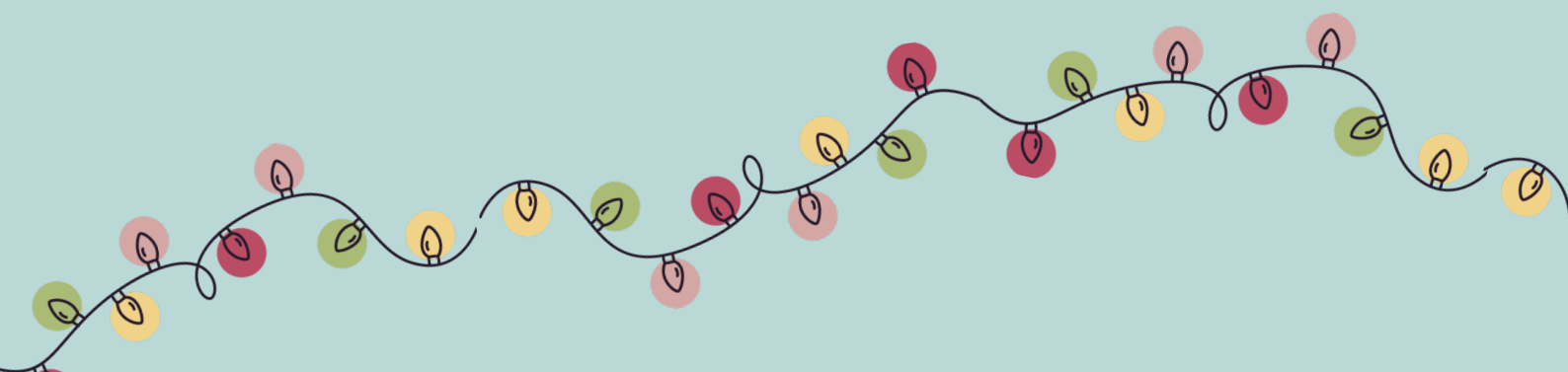


## ROUND 5 - ENGLISH COUNTIES

2. Name the largest county by land area.
3. Name the only county beginning with O.
4. Which county has the largest population? (Source ONS, 2018)
5. Which county is the most northerly?
6. Which county has the smallest population? (Source ONS, 2018)
7. Into which county did Huntingdonshire merge, in 1974?
8. Name the only county beginning with T.
9. Which county's official name is the longest?
10. Name the only county ending in the letter A?





## ROUND 6 - FAMOUS PEOPLE PICTURES

Name the famous people - their real names, not the character.

Scoring: 1 point for each correct full name - first name & second name, except for Question 2.

Question 2 Special Instructions: you only need 1 name per portrait. Note that there are 4 answers for question 2. The names of these four famous Italians are connected in a completely different context.....if you were a young TV watcher during the 1980s, this may help. If you get the connection between these 4, it may help you guess the Xmas-related overall theme. There are no bonus points available for what connects the answers to question 2.

For 5 bonus points, what is the Xmas-related theme covering all 12?

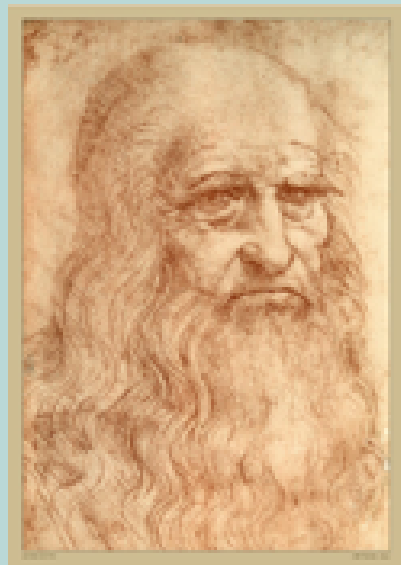
Hints to the theme are either in the person's name, their character's name, or showing in the pictures.

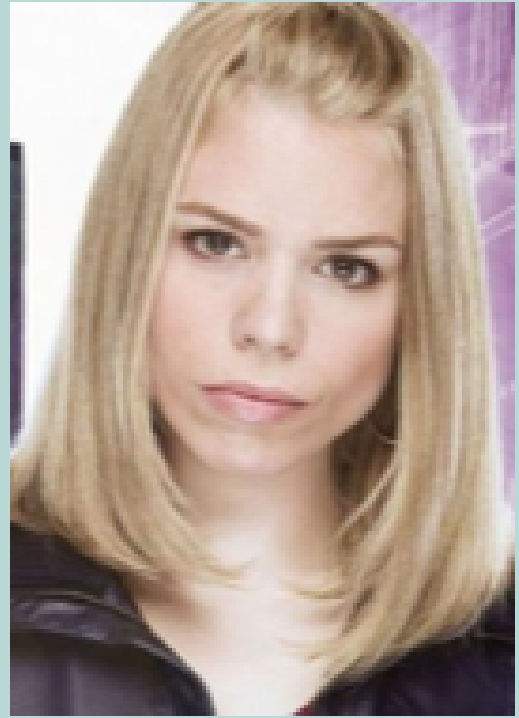

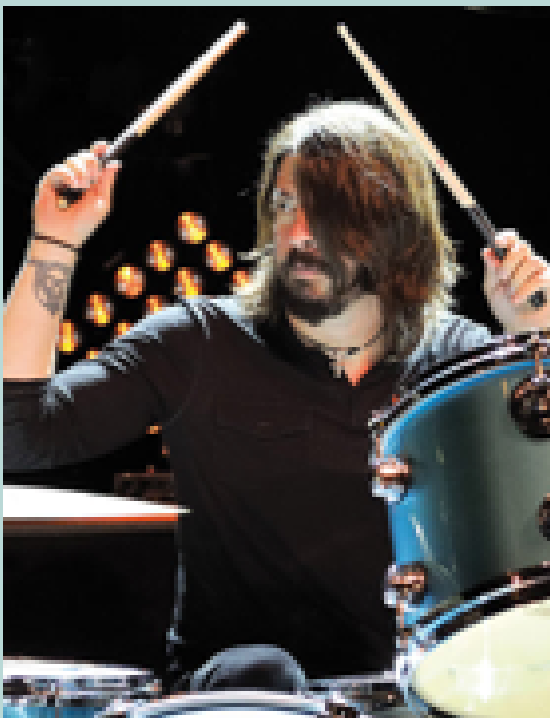

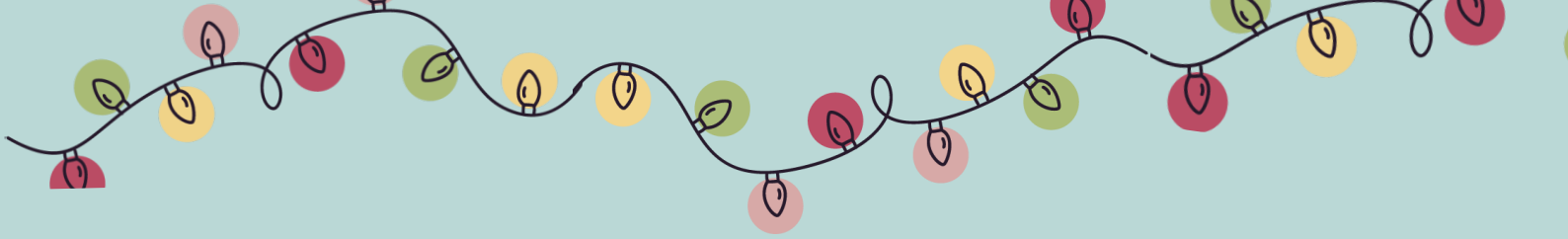
